STUDENT RUNWAY SUBMISSION FEE & BENEFITS: *This is a juried show. If your garment is not selected for the runway your submission fee will be refunded. If selected:*

- 1) Your student \$10 fee will give you free admission, 1 guest ticket and a spot on the runway.
- 2) Middle or Elementary School Student submissions will be in the **first show only** and maybe on display @ the second show.
- 3) Bring your own model, or use one of ours (with advance notice – more information to be provided once your piece is accepted).

RUBBISH RENEWED DEFINITIONS:

- 1) **Trash-fashion:** composed of at least 90% material destined for the trash bin.
 - a. Materials used in the construction of garments must be post-consumer, post-industrial, or post agricultural waste, and must constitute at least 90% of the garment.
 - b. New construction materials may be minimally used such as: glue, tape, dyes, staples, thread, zippers, elastic, wire, Velcro, boning, grommets . . .
 - c. Lining or undergarments ONLY may be constructed of previously used fabric, garments or bolt ends. Percentage of new material should not exceed 10% of total garment.
 - d. Trash-fashion is wearable art and must be of quality construction and made to wear beyond the fashion show.
- 2) **Re-fashion:** made from previously used garments and fabric, refashioning tattered, old stuff into stylish new gems
 - a. Materials used in the construction of re-fashioned garments must be made from previously used items and reconstructed into something entirely new.
 - b. Use of materials and garments beyond repair and destined for the landfill is encouraged.
 - c. New construction materials may be minimally used such as: glue, tape, dyes, staples t., thread, zippers, elastic, wire, Velcro, boning, grommets . . .
 - d. Re-fashion is wearable art and must be of quality construction and made to wear beyond the fashion show.
- 3) **NOT Acceptable Materials:**
 - a. New materials and items beyond 10% of the overall garment.
 - b. Unsafe materials such as those that give off fumes, chemicals, or particulate matter.
 - c. Materials that are sharp or poorly fastened to garment.

RUNWAY SELECTION PROCESS & CRITERIA

Runway entries may be submitted as either **Trash-fashion** or **Re-fashion**. Entries will be juried (exception made for business challenge entries). Jury is made up of three community members. Jury members will use the description of your piece and photos of the finished garment, OR, if construction is in-progress – photos of the garment in process, a detailed sketch and description, to score the garment. Artists may submit up to 3 complete garments. No more than 2 pieces will be selected from a single artist (exceptions made for business challenge entries). All decisions are final.

Selection Criteria –

Elementary & Middle School Student submissions will be in the first show only

Furthering Rubbish Renewed Mission - Description & piece communicate:

Transforming trash, inspiring community for a sustainable earth

Use of Materials - Transformation of trash into fashion. Must fit definitions above

Design - Coherence; Innovative techniques; Unique aesthetics; Creative expression

Quality of Construction - Construction methods inspire long-term use

Runway Submission MUST Include:

- Completed submission form (last page of this packet)
 - \$10 Student fee (checks accepted, made out to *REALMS for Rubbish Renewed*)
 - Fashion Description
 - Artist's statement (optional)
 - 3 quality photographs** of the following:
 - Completed garment being submitted
- OR**
- Piece in progress (mostly complete) + a detailed sketch of the garment

Fashion Runway Descriptions

Each fashion creation entry needs a title, by-line, and concise description of the piece. The description should include your use of materials, inspiration, and connection to our mission of ***Transforming trash, inspiring community for a sustainable earth.*** Make it fun, entertaining and appropriate for all ages. These descriptions will be used to inspire the final description used by our MC. *Rubbish Renewed reserves the right to alter statements to fit the show's timing and feel.*

Artist's Statement (optional)

Please send us your artist's statement. We may include excerpts from your statement in promotional materials. This statement is a place to include more information about your artwork, your background and where you go to school.

Notification of selection

Artists will be notified within one week of the deadline by email &/or phone. If your piece is selected, it will be for **one show only** with exceptions made for business challenge, auction items, and number needed for show duration. If your submission is not selected all applicable entry fees will be returned. REALMS students will receive an invitation for an alternate event at school.
